Classical/rock violinist Daisy Jopling was born in London, and now lives in NY. She has toured the world with her own band, the Daisy Jopling Band and with the creative string trio Triology. She has recorded 9 albums, 2 with BMG RCA Victor.

Daisy Jopling studied the violin with Frances Mason and Itzhak Rashkovsky at the London Royal College of Music, David Takeno at the London Guildhall School of Music and Drama, and Boris Kuschnir at the Vienna Conservatory, Austria.

At the age of 14 Daisy made her concerto debut at the Royal Albert Hall in London. She has since performed in major festivals and concert halls throughout the world, including Salzburger Festspiele, Edinburgh International Festival, the Musikverein in Vienna and the Carnegie Hall and Lincoln Center in New York.

With her own band and the creative string trio "Triology" Daisy has toured in Austria, Germany, Switzerland, Italy, France, Spain, Sweden, Norway, England, Ukraine, Hungary, Slovenia, Slovakia, Croatia, Japan, China, Korea, Australia, Singapore, Turkey, Saudi Arabia, Mexico and the USA.

Daisy was the first ever international violinist to perform at the Great Pyramids of Giza in Cairo, Egypt, collaborating with Egyptian stars Hany Adel and Wust El Balad.





Daisy's music has been on television worldwide, and her own shows have aired on PBS in 2017, 2021 and 2022.

She has collaborated, recorded and performed with superstars worldwide including Bobby McFerrin and Rob Evan from the US, Hollywood's Hans Zimmer and Daniel Flannery, India's Shubha Mudgal, Cuba's Omara Portuondo, Africa's Oliver Mtukutsi, Austria's Joe Zawinul, Wolfgang Muthspiel and Julian Rachlin, The Netherland's Janine Jansen, Russia's Boris, Grebenshikov, Egypt's Hany Adel and Wust El Balad, and London's Tony Award Winning director Tom Morris. She also performed at the United Nations Assembly Hall in New York alongside Akon, Gilberto Gil, Ky-Mani Marley, Salif Keita, The Blind Boys of Alabama, Phylicia Rashad, Whoopi Goldberg and Carl Lewis.

With the Chamber Orchestra of Europe Daisy has performed with Mstislav Rostropovich, Martha Argerich, Vladimir Ashkenazy, Vanessa Mae, Claudio Abbado, Bernard Haitink, Carlo Maria Guilini and Nikolaus Harnoncourt.
